Unlocking the Potential of the Poultry Industry in Africa: Strategies for Sustainable Development in Challenging Environments: Dr Clement Adjorlolo. The Head of Agriculture and Rural Transformation at the African Union-NEPAD (New Partnership for Africa's Development)

DR CLEMENT ADJORLOLO

Dr. Clement Adjorlolo is an accomplished scientist specializing in Earth Observation and Agroecological Monitoring. He currently serves as the Head of the Agriculture and Rural Transformation Programme at the African Union Development Agency (AUDA-NEPAD). In this role, he provides strategic leadership in implementing the Comprehensive African Agricultural Development Programme (CAADP), focusing on country-level support for the technical review, formulation, and execution of National Agriculture Investment Plans (NAIPs) and Regional Agriculture Investment Plans (RAIPs). He also plays a key role in supporting the CAADP Biennial Review (BR) reporting process, which tracks and evaluates progress toward agricultural transformation across Africa.

Dr. Adjorlolo is also a co-leader of the African Seed and Biotechnology Programme (ASBP), where he helps drive initiatives to strengthen seed systems and promote the use of biotechnology for sustainable agricultural development. Moreover, he leads the development of innovative digital tools designed to support the implementation of agrifood systems policy instruments and enable comprehensive performance monitoring at the continental, regional and national levels.
