Invited Speaker – Climate change adaptation in poultry production: Prof Kwaku Adomako (Univ. of Science and Technology, Ghana)

## **PROF KWAKU ADOMAKO**

Prof. Kwaku Adomako holds a BSc (Hons) and PhD in Animal Breeding and Genetics from KNUST, along with specialized training in poultry production (Hebrew University, Israel) and molecular genetics (University of Georgia, USA). He has been with KNUST since 2011 and is currently an Associate Professor in the Department of Animal Science.

He previously headed the Dairy/Beef Cattle Research Station (2017–2019) and the Poultry Section (2012–2017). Prof. Adomako serves as External Examiner for multiple universities in Ghana and is Vice-President of the Ghana Society of Animal Production.

With over 70 peer-reviewed publications, he has supervised numerous postgraduate and undergraduate theses and secured over one million Ghana Cedis in research grants. He is a frequent presenter at international conferences and actively supports capacity-building for poultry and rabbit value chain actors.
